I hope you are settling nicely into your new role. I am writing today following up on Written Question 61362 which I asked of your predecessor.

In the question I asked about public health target allocations and whether there was room to review allocations, which in the case of Plymouth City Council are particularly unfair in comparison with other councils, both in similar demography, but also compared to more wealthy areas.

In her reply, the Minister said the question of target allocations would be reviewed in light of the Department for Communities and Local Government's consultation. Has the Department of Health been able to progress with this review? Regardless if they have or not, I would be very keen to meet with you to talk about public health in Plymouth, both regarding the things that are going well and the services that are delivered very effectively, but also the stark challenges, including that of funding.
